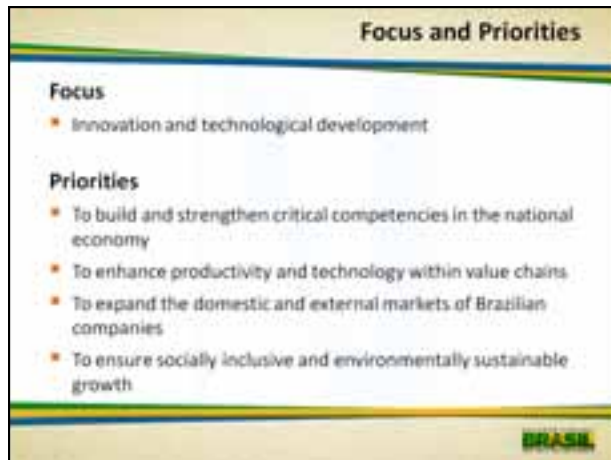


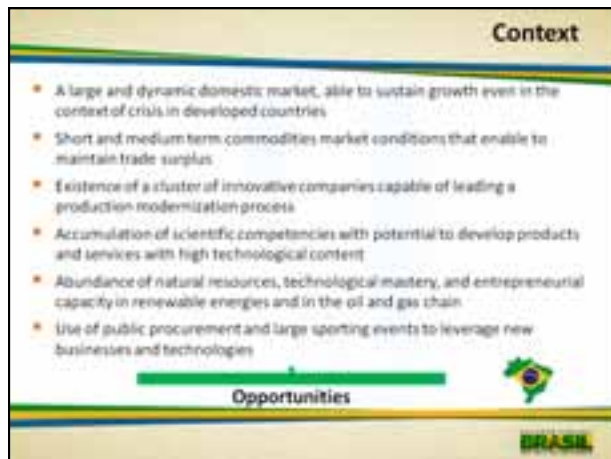












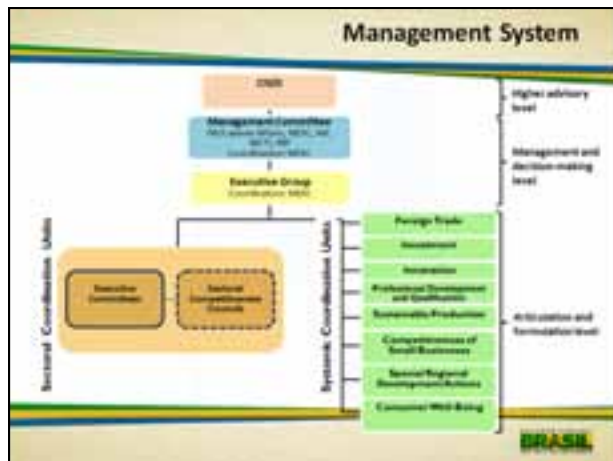
Context

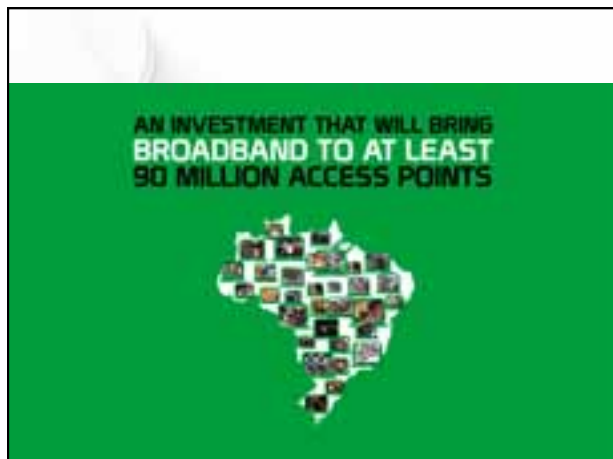

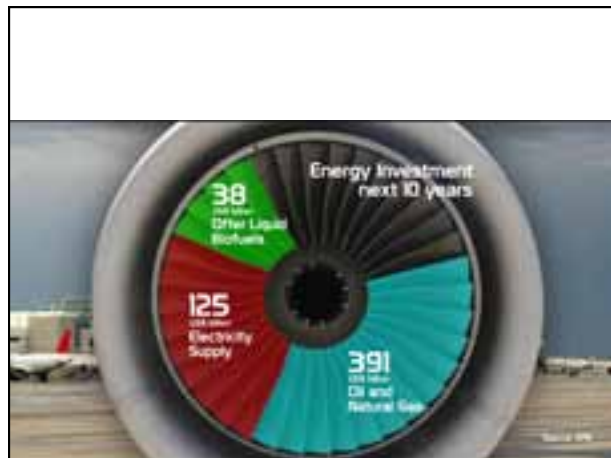
